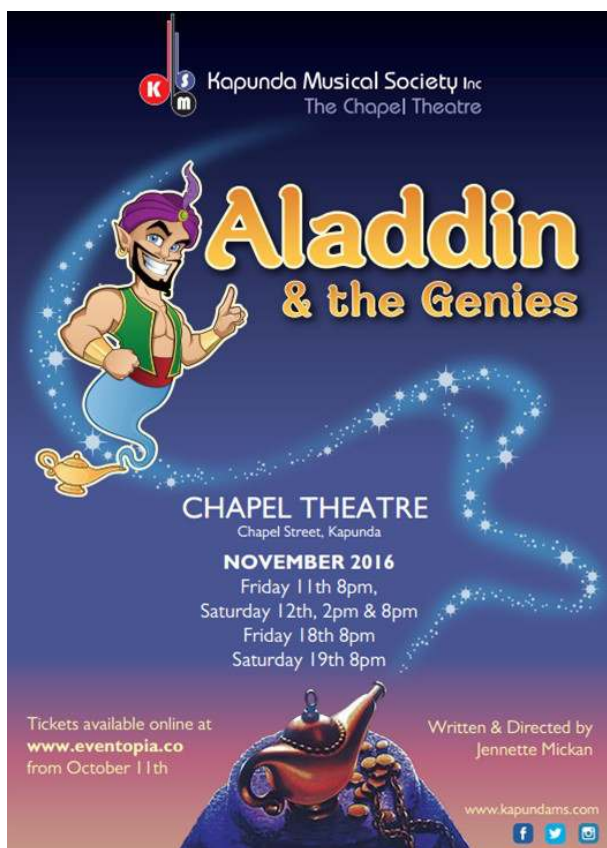


KBA working party meetings
